

Hayton CE School Sports Premium 2020-21

The Sports Premium grant is ring-fenced and must be used to fund improvements to the provision of PE and sport for the benefit of pupils aged 5 – 11 years old, so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles. Allocations for the academic year 2019-20 are calculated using the number of pupils in Years 1 to 6, as recorded in the January 2019 census as follows:

- Schools with 17 or more eligible pupils receive £16,000 plus £10 per eligible pupil.
- Schools with 16 or fewer eligible pupils receive £1000 per eligible pupil.

The Sport Premium is to fund Physical Education, School Sport and Physical Activity, to make additional and sustainable improvements in the quality of PE and sport offered to pupils.

These are the five key indicators where improvement is expected:

- 1) The Engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity-the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend that all children and young people aged 5-18 engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day, of which 30 minutes should be in school.
- 2) The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
- 3) Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- 4) Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils.
- 5) Increased participation in competitive sport.

Curriculum

At Hayton School we believe that physical education is an important part of our children's education, and recognise its contribution to the health and wellbeing of our pupils. We believe that an innovative, varied P.E. curriculum along with extra-curricular opportunities have a positive influence on the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of all our children.

Throughout the school year the pupils have been coached and taught a variety of skills and sports at an age appropriate level to most year groups. These include football, basic skills, multi skills, running, dance, gymnastics, netball, pickleball (Year 4 only) and swimming (Years 5 & 6). A Wheelchair Basketball Champion visited and children were able to participate in activities in wheelchairs leading to a greater understanding of the diversity of sport. They listened to the champions inspiring story.

As part of our partnership with the William Howard Primary Consortium, Carlisle School Sports Association and the Brampton Primary Schools Cluster we are normally able to take part in a variety of competitions and festivals with other schools.

The effect of Covid-19 on our PE Curriculum

During the Covid-19 Pandemic we were able to keep undertaking PE lessons within lesson time, when we were open for all pupils, and promote a regular physical exercise activity each week during periods of remote learning. Swimming lessons ran for Years 5 and 6. We were also fortunate enough to be able to run residential for Year 3, 4, 5 & 6 to fulfil the Adventurous and Outdoor Education criteria of the PE Curriculum. We were able to run individual Sports Days for each class (Nursery to Year 6) in order to allow all pupils to take part in competitive sport. Pupils had the opportunity to attend extra-curricular clubs run by Carlisle United Football Club. The Outward Bound Trust also came into school to work with Year 6 in December to promote team work skills building.

CPD

Staff undertook training looking specifically at socially distanced PE and the holistic approach to PE linked to PHSE, pupil well-being and self-esteem.

Competitions

There have been no face to face competitions during the academic year 2020-21 due to the COVID 19 situation.

Festivals

There were no sporting festivals during the academic year 2020-21
